- Inpatient diagnostic services include but are not limited to EEG, long-term EEG monitoring service and evoked potentials
- Management of spasticity, dystonia, neck, head and back pain and other central nervous system disorders with Botox® treatments
- Written consultation reports and plan of treatment within seven days for referring physicians

## Scheduling appointments

Consultation with Dr. Alapati, Dr. Mengesha and Dr. Greer is by appointment only and initially made through the primary care physician's office. Please bring the following items to your appointment:

*Current insurance card and picture identification*

*Current medications or a complete list of medicines with doses, including all over-the-counter medications, herbs and vitamins*

*Method of payment (cash, check, Discover, MasterCard and Visa)*

## Canceling appointments

If it is necessary to cancel an appointment, please notify the clinic at least 24 hours in advance. This is an important courtesy to others waiting to schedule an appointment.

## Telephone calls

All messages are given to the appropriate personnel as soon as possible, and every attempt is made to return telephone calls during regular work hours. There are times, however, when we cannot return calls on the same day they are received. Calls received after 4 p.m. are responded to the next clinic day. Urgent phone calls are responded to on the same day the call was received, during regular clinic hours. So we can accurately reach you, confirm your contact telephone numbers with our office.

## Prescription refills

Refills should be requested during regular office visits. Your options for refills outside of office visits include:

- Contacting your local or mail-order pharmacy directly and requesting that a refill request be faxed to the clinic at (256) 265-6386.
- Submitting your request on the telephone refill request line by pressing "2" when calling the office. Be prepared with the patient name, date of birth, name of prescription, dosage, frequency of the requested medication, pharmacy name, pharmacy phone number and patient return telephone number. Please allow 72 hours for refills to be completed.

Controlled substances cannot be prescribed or refilled by phone and must be picked up in person with proper identification.

## Insurance

Most insurance policies are accepted including Medicare, Medicaid, Tricare and Blue Cross/Blue Shield.

# Contact guidelines

## Emergency

If you have an emergency, call 911 or go to the nearest emergency department for care. This clinic does not administer acute medical treatment.

## Urgent problems

If you have an urgent concern, call us at (256) 265-2695. After-hours calls will be transferred to the answering service. The answering service will page the physician on call. If your urgent concern becomes an emergency, go to the nearest emergency department for care or call 911.

## After-hours questions

Please call us the next working day during business hours for general questions.

## Lab or test results

Please call us during regular business hours. We are unable to retrieve results after clinic hours.
